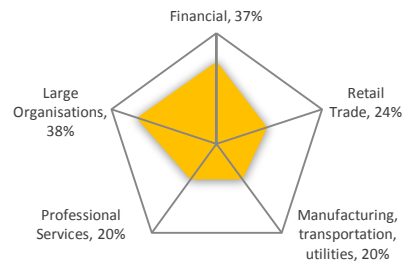

Who are the cybercriminals' victims

Every business is a potential victim of a cyber attack. The motives, methods and opportunities may differ, but it has been found that the following types of organisations are even more at risk:

- ▶ **Favourite target – anyone who has a large number of files containing debit/credit card data**, e.g. financial institutions and retail trade. In Singapore, cybercriminals have their eye on large companies with more than 2,500 employees – in particular the finance, insurance and real estate industry.#
- ▶ **Some cybercrimes target SMEs** because of the lower likelihood that those organisations would have adequate information security controls to prevent the crime. The largest growth area of all targeted malicious attacks was entities with >250 employees – 31% of all attacks.#
